FUZZY WUZZY



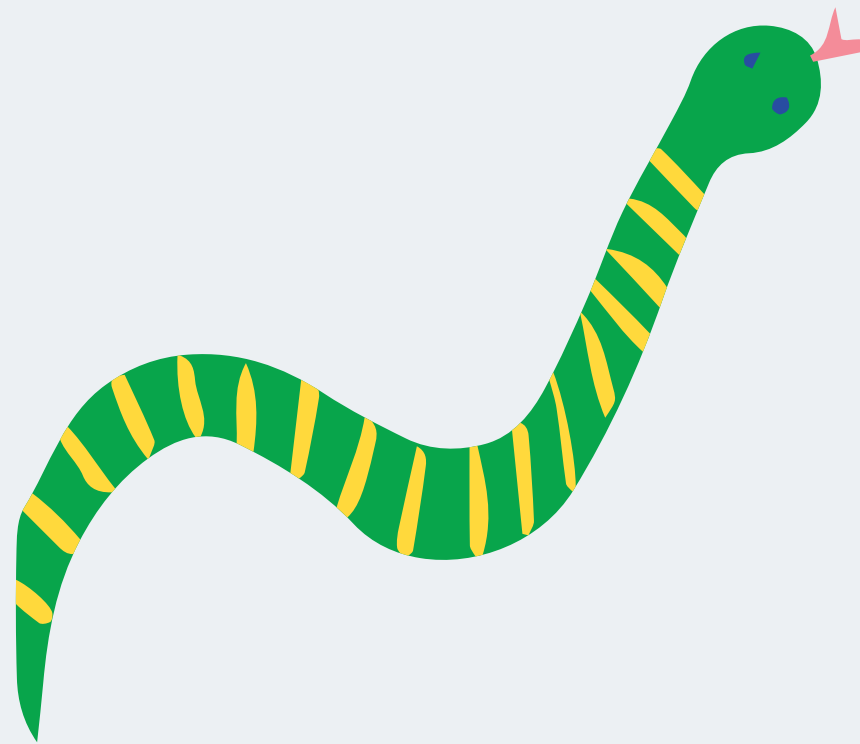
**Fuzzy wuzzy was a bear.

TRICKY, FRISKY SNAKE



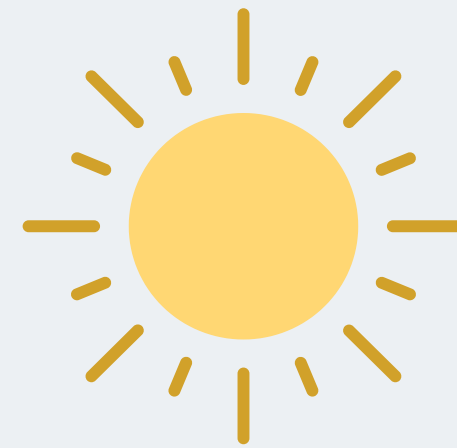
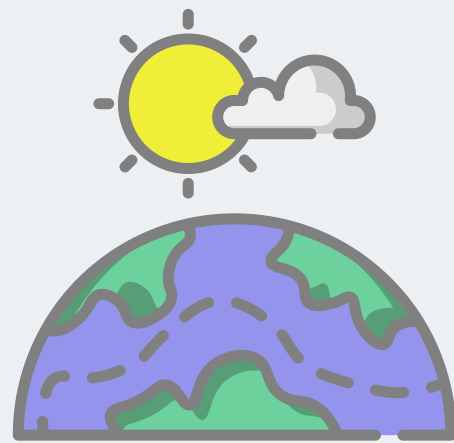
**A tricky, frisky snake with sixty super

TWO WITCHES



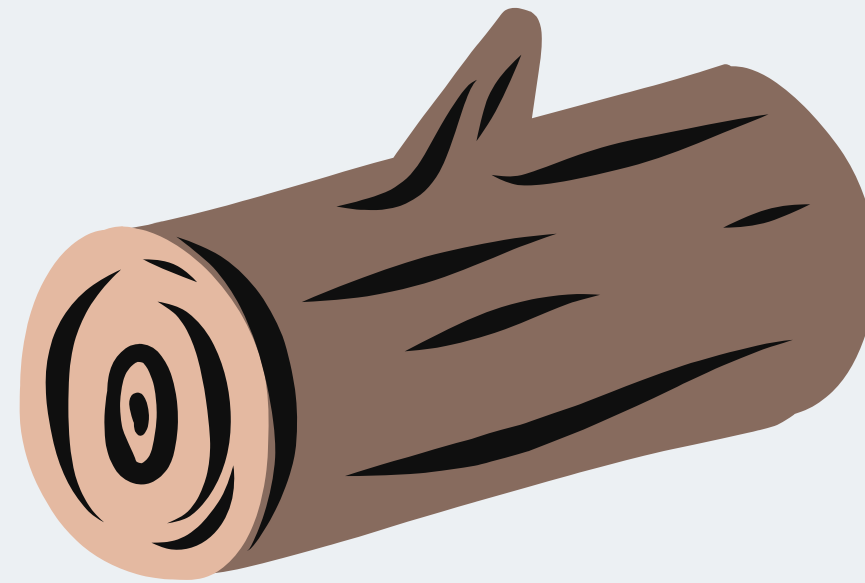
**If two witches were watching two
